
New Clinical App Features

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Guide - Patient Identification



"First Name" and "Last Name" fields have been changed to say, "Line 1" and "Line 2". The optional Patient ID field has been changed to "Reference ID (optional)"

You can continue to enter first and last name or use unique identifiers in those lines.

Please use these guidelines for deciding how to use these new fields:


- 1 Line 1 and Line 2 are mandatory
- 2 The fields are limited to 25 characters
- Both lines will be printed on the orthotic
- All three fields are searchable on your patient page.



Entering First and Last Name only









Example 2

Entering unique identification numbers and a PO









Example 3

Entering First and Last name and Clinic Information








Heel Cut Out

New Modification

You now have the ability to order a heel cutout in the UI. The cutout is 1" in diameter and automatically applies when selected. You will be able to view the cutout in the Visualizer tool before hitting submit.








New Modifications Available

Type of finishing instructions received frequently Save in Preferred Prescriptions Manually applied, will not show up in visualizer Three section: Shell, cover and Accommodations

Other Shell Modifications

Modification	Description
Widen forefoot at shell	
Cutout at 5th MPJ	This will create a rounded cutout in the shell at the distal 5 th mpj area
Cut out at base of 5th met	This is the same as a 5 th metabase accommodation
Accommodate the base of 5th met	This will create a well or button-out area under the 5 th metabase
Accommodate the navicular	This will create a well or button-out area under the navicular
Accommodate the heel	Should only be used with a RF heel post, this modification creates a depression under the heel to offload



Other Coverings

Modification	Description
Widen / Lengthen top cover throughout 2 sizes	For example, a size 12 cover template will be used on a size 10 shell
Widen top cover at forefoot only 2 sizes	We will leave the forefoot portion of the top cover wider / longer at the forefoot area only
Add navicular wing	This is a curved raised area of the top cover along the medial arch of the orthotic in the area of the navicular. It will pad navicular prominences that lie above the shell.



Other Accommodations

Modification	Description
1/16" poron backfill	Poron fill for selected accommodations. Not needed usually if a midlayer of 1/16" or greater is selected.
EVA reinforcement from heel to mets	This could affect turnaround times. Similar results can be achieved by increasing rigidity of the shell as a consideration.
EVA arch reinforcement	This could affect turnaround times. Similar results can be achieved by increasing rigidity of the shell as a consideration.
1/16" EVA distal FF extension	
Extrinsic tip post lateral	Used when any extrinsic or intrinsic FF posting is selected to balance the FF to the RF.
Extrinsic tip post medial	Used when any extrinsic or intrinsic FF posting is selected to balance the FF to the RF.
Extrinsic FF post lateral	Used when any extrinsic or intrinsic FF posting is selected to balance the FF to the RF.
Extrinsic FF post medial	Used when any extrinsic or intrinsic FF posting is selected to balance the FF to the RF.
